




Elite-wenners skitter in Bloemfontein

SA Stud Book hosted a beef cattle information day at the Southwell sportsgrounds (in the Port Alfred area) on Wednesday 16 April 2025. A big thank you from SA Stud Book to stud breeder Justin Stirk of Frontier Bonsmaras and the local cricket club for allowing us the opportunity to use their facilities.

The stud breeders who attended the day were treated to intense and fruitful discussions during the presentations.

The guest speaker was Dr Marette Dreyer from the Kariega Veterinary Clinic who spoke about the value of and practices relating to good herd health management.

SA Stud Book's Herman Labuschagne discussed the importance of accurately recording traits of economic importance.

Jason Reding pointed out the value of participation in the Beef Genomics Program (BGP2) and how the information will benefit future selection and breeding.

Stirk shared his views as a breeder, followed by a visit to his farm to view future herd sires bred by him.



The genetics of polledness has been of major interest to cattle breeders and livestock geneticists. The current revolution in the use of genomics has allowed for the unravelling of the true genetic mechanism that controls the expression of horns or polledness in livestock. Referred to as the polled gene, this gene is located on chromosome 1 of the cow genome.

The first mutation (form of the gene) was identified in Brahman cattle and is called the Celtic variant. This is the main mutation causing polledness in beef and dairy cattle worldwide, and was confirmed in the Bonsmara and Drakensberger breeds by Grobler et al. (2018). The Celtic variant is the main mutation causing polledness in South African cattle breeds but is not the only one.
